

## Water District Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Rate

Frisco West Water Control and Improvement District of Denton County will hold a public hearing on a proposed tax rate for the tax year 2020 on Tuesday, September 15, 2020, at 6:30 p.m. **solely by Zoom audio/video conference**. Any member of the public may participate in this meeting remotely by going to <http://zoom.us> or calling (346) 248-7799 and joining meeting ID **822 1018 7928**; and entering passcode **090866**. However, should the Texas Governor's March 13, 2020, Proclamation regarding COVID-19 expire prior to the date of this meeting, the meeting will be held in person at the Frisco West Municipal Center, 1230 Brendan Drive, Little Elm, Texas 75068. Your individual taxes may increase or decrease, depending on the tax rate that is adopted and on the change in the taxable value of your property in relation to the change in taxable value of all other property. The change in the taxable value of your property in relation to the change in the taxable value of all other property determines the distribution of the tax burden among all property owners.

### NOTICE OF TAXPAYERS' RIGHT TO ELECTION TO REDUCE TAX RATE

If the district adopts a combined debt service, operation and maintenance and contract tax rate that would result in the taxes on the average residence homestead increasing by more than 3.5 percent, an election must be held to determine whether to approve the operation and maintenance tax rate under Section 49.23602, Water Code. The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state
